



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
HIS MAJESTY'S SECRETARIAT, THE KINGDOM OF BHUTAN
AND
CHIANG MAI RAJABHAT UNIVERSITY, THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND

To strengthen academic cooperation and exchange between the two parties and to promote practices and research as well as the mutual exchange of talents for sustainable community development, His Majesty's Secretariat, the Kingdom of Bhutan and Chiang Mai Rajabhat University (CMRU), the Kingdom of Thailand, made this cooperation and collaboration upon consultation.

Scope of Cooperation and Collaboration

1. Chiang Mai Rajabhat University will accept the selected individuals from the Kingdom of Bhutan for study visits or for field practices in various areas in Chiang Mai Province and Mae Hong Son Province. These study visits or field practices include the areas such as the application of the King's philosophy, development of the OTOP products, the new theory agriculture, and the organic agriculture.
2. His Majesty's Secretariat, Kingdom of Bhutan will facilitate academics, lecturers and students from the University to participate in the study visits and academic exchanges with organizations and communities in the Kingdom of Bhutan.
3. The University will offer the two annual scholarships for five consecutive years, ten scholarships in total, to the qualified individuals selected by the Kingdom of Bhutan to study in the following programs.
 - 1) Doctor of Philosophy Program in Community Energy and Environment
 - 2) Doctor of Philosophy Program in Science for Sustainable Local Development
 - 3) Master of Science Program in Community Energy and Environment
 - 4) Master of Arts Program in Science for Sustainable Local Development
 - 5) Bachelor of Arts Program in English for International Communication
 - 6) Bachelor of Business Administration Program in Global Business Management
 - 7) Bachelor of Business Administration Program in Aviation Business Management
 - 8) Other degree programs later agreed by both parties

Details of the scholarships are as stated in the particulars attached.

4. His Majesty's Secretariat, Kingdom of Bhutan will select two candidates each year for the duration of the Memorandum of Understanding.


The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this Memorandum of Understanding shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by the two parties prior to the initiation of that activity. Any of such agreements entered into, as outlined above, will form appendices to this Memorandum of Understanding. Each party shall designate a liaison officer to develop and coordinate the specific activities agreed upon.

Renewal, Termination and Amendment

This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in force for five years from the date of the final signature, with the understanding that it may be terminated by each party giving 6 (six) months notice to the other party in writing, unless an earlier termination date is mutually agreed upon. The Memorandum of Understanding may be amended or extended between the two parties in writing as an addendum to this agreement.



SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS FROM THE KINGDOM OF BHUTAN TO STUDY IN THE STATED PROGRAMS AT CHIANG MAI RAJABHAT UNIVERSITY

No.	Details	Amount of Scholarship (Baht)
1.	Tuition fee (For the period of study program plan)	Actual cost based on the CMRU announcement on the tuition fee (The tuition fee will be varied in each program.)
2.	Accommodation fee (CMRU provides on-campus accommodation at CMRU International Dormitory. This accommodation fee will be applied only for off-campus accommodation.)	Maximum 3,000 baht per month
3.	Books and instructional materials	Maximum 10,000 baht per year
4.	Monthly stipend (For the prescribed period of study program)	Maximum 10,000 baht per month
5.	International airfare for economy class (From Paro, Bhutan to Bangkok, Thailand)	Actual cost but not exceed 20,000 baht
6.	Domestic airfare for economy class (From Bangkok to Chiang Mai)	Actual cost but not exceed 4,000 baht
7.	Accommodation fee in Bangkok for the first arrival date in Thailand (if any)	Actual cost but not exceed 1,500 baht
8.	Transportation expenses from Bangkok airport to accommodation in Bangkok (if any)	Actual cost but not exceed 1,000 baht
9.	Non-immigration visa fee	Actual cost but not exceed 2,000 baht
10.	Life and health insurance fee	Actual cost but not exceed 5,000 baht per year
11.	Other expenses Medical expenses: the expenses that are non-health insurance coverage, medical examination fee, etc. Educational expenses: application and admission fee, registration fee, etc. (Each item will be sponsored upon the president's approval)	Actual cost but not exceed 20,000 baht per year
12.	Other expenses for graduate students (if any): Thesis examination fee, comprehensive examination fee, etc. (Each item will be sponsored upon the president's approval)	Actual cost
13.	Domestic airfare for economy class (From Chiang Mai to Bangkok)	Actual cost but not exceed 4,000 baht
14.	International airfare for economy class (From Bangkok to Paro, Bhutan)	Actual cost but not exceed 20,000 baht
15.	Accommodation fee in Bangkok for the departure date to Bhutan (if any)	Actual cost but not exceed 1,500 baht
